

## Onur Genç's statements in BBVA's commitment to the community between 2021 and 2025

Sustainability is a strategic priority for BBVA.

Our goal is to contribute both to the fight against climate change and to inclusive growth.

In July, we took our 2025 Sustainability Pledge a step further when we doubled our commitment to channel 200 billion euros by 2025 in sustainable financing.

Regarding inclusive growth, today we announce that between 2021 and 2025 we will contribute 550 million euros to community initiatives. This is a joint effort of BBVA and our foundations with three main action lines:

- First, reduce inequality and promote entrepreneurship,
- Second, create opportunities for all through education,
- And third, support research and culture.

This is our most ambitious community investment plan to date. BBVA will support 5 million entrepreneurs, will provide quality education to more than 3 million people and will train 1 million people in financial education. Additionally, the BBVA MicroFinance Foundation will grant more than 7 billion euros in microloans.

Through these initiatives BBVA aims to reach 100 million people worldwide, contributing to our purpose: To bring the age of opportunity to everyone.
